An architectural design of the National Museum of Memory in Bogota, Colombia (above), created by College of Architecture and Design associate professor Maria Hurtado de Mendoza, recently won an international competition launched by the National Centre for Historical Memory in association with the Colombian Society of Architects. The project, a joint venture between Hurtado de Mendoza's Madrid-based practice estudio.entresitio and the Colombian firm MGP, was selected from among 72 entries worldwide and is part of a government effort to honor the victims of the Colombian conflict and their path toward peace. Construction is slated to begin August 2016.
